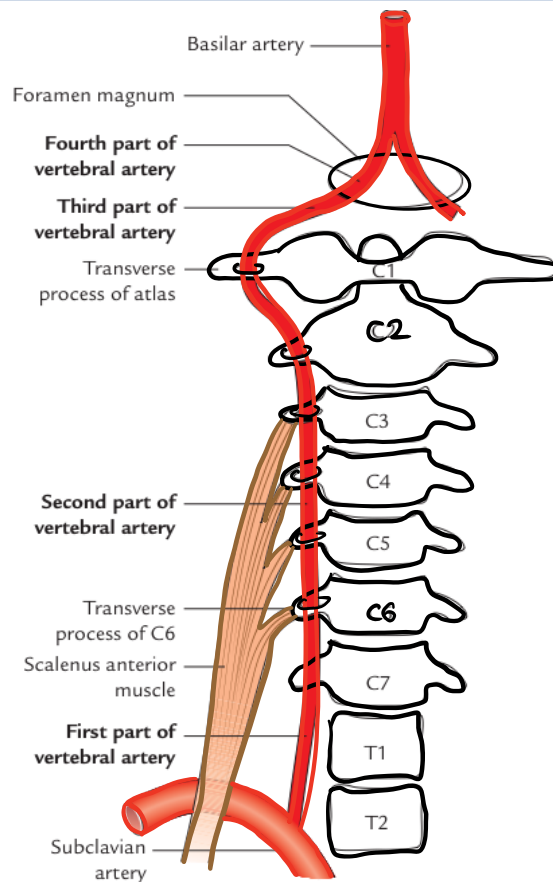
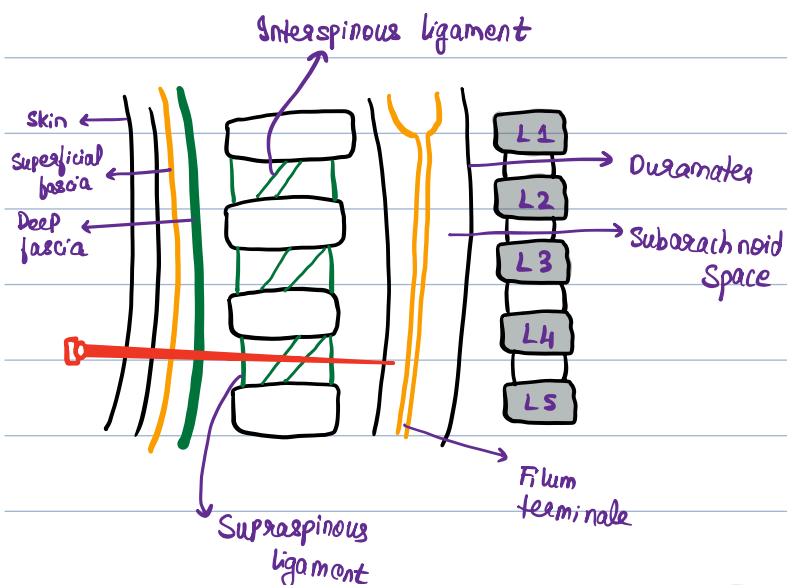
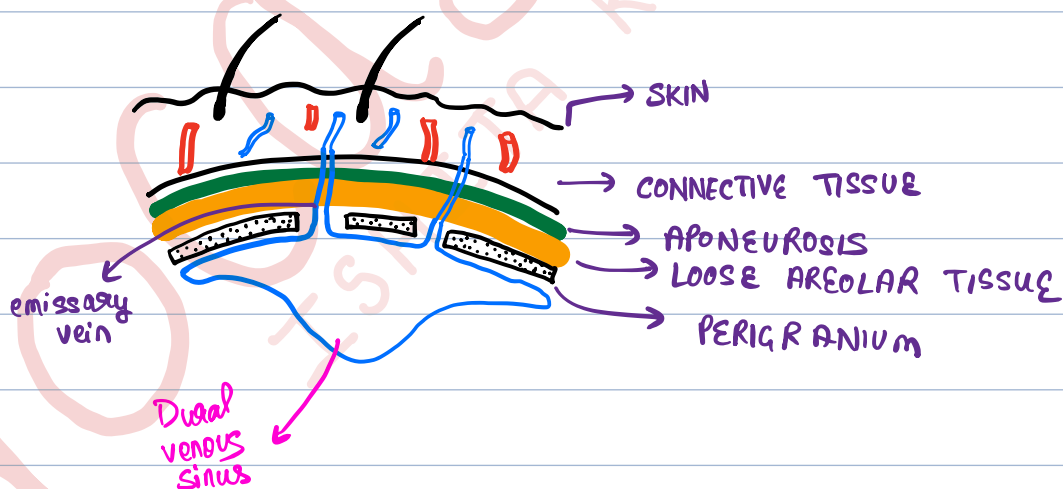


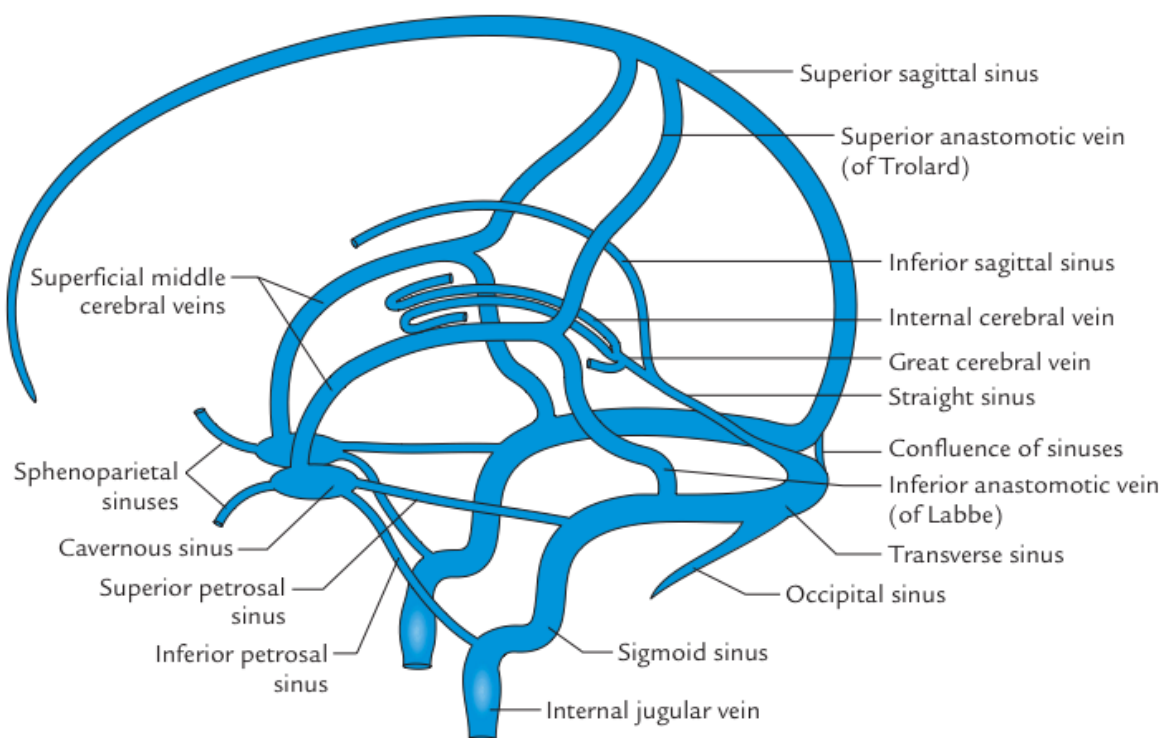
Fig. 16.6 Course and parts of the vertebral artery.
